Application Procedures

- Submit general Application for Employment
 - Request references to be sent to:

 - Submit a supplemental application (Form No. 8027) for each vacant position for which you are qualified and interested
- Note:* All Applications for Employment must contain applicant's signature to be valid

Reference Procedures

- Three work related references are requested using the district form provided and must be completed by persons having knowledge of your work (preferably current or former supervisors). It is recommended that you include with your application a resume, applicable transcripts, and any additional letter(s) of reference
- It is the applicant's responsibility to mail the enclosed reference forms to the appropriate persons, listing on the back of the general application the names and addresses of those individuals who will be providing references
- Reference forms are to be mailed directly to the Sweetwater Union High School District by the person(s) providing the reference and are not to be returned to the applicant
- All reference and/or skill certificates must be on file in the Human Resources Department within 30 days of the application date. Skills certificates for specific posted positions must be submitted no later than 3 (three) workdays following the deadline date of the vacancy applied for
