Who is eligible?

Employees and spouses/partners who are enrolled on the California Schools VEBA-sponsored Cigna, UHC, UMR or SIMNSA plans are eligible for the Kindbody benefit

Coverage overview

- Up to 1 full KindCycle including in vitro fertilization (IVF), intrauterine insemination (IUI) with fertility medication through KindbodyRx
- Conception, fertility, and male assessments to help you learn more about your fertility
- 6 sessions of virtual holistic health services; support includes menopause, mental well-being, nutrition, doula/birth coaches, lactation support, back-to-work care, and more
- Access to Kindbody's menopause program offering specialty providers who will support women experiencing menopause; services include lifestyle assessment, hormone testing, and virtual holistic sessions

Note: Employees and spouses/partners enrolled on the California Schools VEBA - sponsored Kaiser plan will have access to VEBA discounted rates at Kindbody Signature clinics. Additionally, VEBA members seeking services for fertility preservation (i.e., egg freezing) will have access to discounted rates at Kindbody Signature clinics. These direct discounts are offered directly by Kindbody and not through the California Schools VEBA benefit program.

VEBA Direct HMO Cont.

VEBA Direct HMO phase one will launch January 1, 2024, across southern San Diego County:

- 15 districts were selected to participate in this launch
- If your district was selected to be part of the launch, you received information about it in your rate packet
- Districts were selected based on how closely their current enrollment matched with VEBA Direct HMO network medical groups.

VEBA communications will be sent to all phase one districts for their Open Enrollment needs.

Member communications of this change will be mailed to all those currently enrolled in Performance HMO Network 1 to inform them of automatic move to the new VEBA Direct HMO.

• Any non-matching members will be auto-assigned a new PCP and may choose to actively enroll.





Acupuncture Benefit

GoodRx

Price Assure through GoodRx

Implemented in April of 2023, the Price Assure program allows members to pay the lowest possible amount for generic medications. Price Assure is a collaboration between Express Scripts and GoodRx, a digital platform that provides access to lower prices for brand and generic medications.

Members automatically save on generic medications when they take their prescriptions to innetwork pharmacies that also accept GoodRx. If the GoodRx price is lower than the copay, the member pays the lower price. Because it's processed through Express Scripts, the prescription automatically processes with the savings, while applying the cost to the Member's deductible, accumulator and out-of-pocket costs—all without having to sign up for a separate GoodRx card.



Waived Medication Copays

- Hypertension, diabetes, and high cholesterol are some of our members' most common health challenges. Copays are waived for generic hypertension, preferred generic oral hypoglycemic, and preferred generic cholesterol medications when filled at a Smart90 retail or mail-order pharmacy.
- To help manage these conditions, members have zero copays for generic hypertension drugs and oral hypoglycemic through home delivery or Smart90
- Members can start these maintenance drugs at their regular retail pharmacy up to 3 fills prior to utilizing Smart90 retail and home delivery (mail order) with a \$0 copay



ESI SaveOnSP Program

Express Scripts partners with SaveonSP to save you money by waiving copays for over 150 certain covered specialty medications. You can access the list of those medications at <u>www.saveonsp.com/veba</u> to see if you are using a medication included in the program. If you are taking one or more of the listed medications, you must enroll with the SaveOnSP program at 800-683-1074 and have your eligibility confirmed to obtain no financial responsibility for those medications.

Have your physician send a new prescription to Accredo for any specialty medications to be filled as they are your exclusive specialty pharmacy with Express Scripts.

If needed, you can contact Express Scripts at 800.918.8011 to speak to a customer service representative who can assist in contacting your physician. Other important notes:

• This program is for members who are enrolled with the UnitedHealthcare HMO and UMR PPO VEBA plan-sponsored plans as their primary insurance. Members who use Medicare as their primary insurance are not eligible for this program.

- If you are already enrolled in a pharmaceutical manufacturer program, please have your manufacturer program issued ID available when you call. The call will be very short and if you are new to the program, the call will take approximately 10 minutes.
- If you do not enroll with SaveOnSP prior to submitting a specialty prescription to Accredo for filling, a SaveonSP Patient Service Representative will contact you via phone prior to dispensing and assist you with enrollment if your medication is part of the program.

• Certain pharmaceutical manufacturers require annual enrollment. With SaveOnSP, you will only be contacted once a year to ensure you are properly enrolled in the program.

- VEBA offers a standard plan design for retirees and students living:
 - outside California or
 - Inside California but outside the HMO service area
- Coverage highlights
 - Monthly premium cost for OOA dependents is the same as it is for dependents living at home.
 - You must include your dependent's OOA address on the enrollment form so they can be enrolled in an OOA plan that has a local provider network.
 - Dependents will remain in their OOA plan until their permanent address changes. Short-term plan changes such as summer or winter break are not allowed.
 - Dependents who are enrolled in an HMO plan must choose a PCP within 30 miles of their OOA address.



Out-of-Area (OOA) Plans – UMR Solutions for OOA Dependents

All OOA Dependents will be enrolled in Surest (UHC digital PPO) at no premium cost, same as today on VEBA's UMR PPO platform.
