Welcome to the California Schools VEBA. VEBA purchases and administers your health care benefits. What this means to you is that you get more benefits at a more reasonable cost than if your district purchased benefits on its own. Based on your district, you can enroll yourself and your eligible family members in a health plan.

VEBA is committed to helping you and your family be healthy and stay healthy. To make sure you choose the health plan and doctors that are best for you, we encourage you to research all of the plan benefits that are available to you as well as the medical groups and doctors you use. You can do this by visiting the California Office of the Patient Advocate at www.opa.ca.gov.

Section 1. Employee Enrollment Information (ALL employees must complete Parts A, B and C of this section) □ Fill in all the information requested (Kaiser Permanente members plan members do NOT have to include a Primary Care Provider (PCP) name or number. UnitedHealthcare (UHC) HMO members can either include a PCP name OR leave the information blank and have UHC assign a PCP based on your zip code.) □ Check with your employer to determine if domestic partnership coverage is available □ You can enroll your eligible dependents up to age 26 □ Proof of permanent disability is required for dependents over age 26
Section 2. Employee Signature Required for Binding Arbitration Agreement ☐ All employees must sign the Binding Arbitration agreement as a requirement of the plan you select ☐ If you don't sign your health plan's Binding Arbitration agreement your enrollment may be denied
Section 3. UnitedHealthcare (UHC), UMR, and Surest Information Employees enrolling in a UHC HMO, UMR PPO, and/or a Surest PPO Plan must review and sign the "Release of Medical Information" section

Authorization to Release Medical Information

I authorize UnitedHealthCare Insurance Company and its affiliates ("UnitedHealthcare and Affiliates") to obtain, use and disclose my medical, claim or benefit records, including any individually identifiable health information contained in these records. I understand these records may contain information created by other persons or entities (including health care providers) as well as information regarding the use of drug, alcohol, HIV/AIDS, mental health (other than psychotherapy notes), sexually transmitted disease and reproductive health services. I authorize any health care provider, pharmacy benefit manager, other insurer or reinsurer, hospital, clinic or other medical facility, health care clearinghouse, and any of their affiliates, representatives or business associates, who may be in possession of my confidential health information, to disclose my information to UnitedHealthcare and Affiliates. I understand the purpose of the disclosure and use of my information is to allow UnitedHealthcare and Affiliates to make decisions regarding eligibility, enrollment and risk rating. I understand this authorization is voluntary and I may refuse to sign the authorization. My refusal may, however, affect my ability to enroll in the health plan or receive benefits, if permitted by law. I understand I may revoke this authorization at any time by notifying my UnitedHealthcare and Affiliates representative in writing, except to the extent that action has already been taken in reliance on this authorization. I (we) have not given the agent or any other persons any health information not included on the Request for Coverage. I (we) understand that the HMO/insurance company(ies) is not bound by any statements I (we) have made to any agent or to any other persons, if those statements are not written or printed on this Request for Coverage and any attachments. UnitedHealthcare is only seeking to collect information about the current health status of those persons listed on the application. You should not include any genetic information. Please do not include any family medical history information related to genetic services or genetic diseases for which you believe you or your dependents may be at risk.
