All dance attendees and their parents and/or guardians must read and agree to abide by the following dance policies and procedures:

## **Tickets (No Refunds After Purchase!)**

- ❖ Tickets are available for sale in the ASB:
  - Eastlake High Students:
    - \$65 Early Bird Pricing until September 13 - \$75 from 9/16-9/30 - \$85 until October 15<sup>th</sup>
- ❖ A student ID must be presented to enter the dance. Students will be denied entry if their name is not on the guest list and exchange of tickets is prohibited.

## **Dance Rules**

All dance attendees and their parents and/or guardians must read and agree to abide by the following dance policies and procedures:

### **Entrance & Departure**

- ❖ \* No guest 21 years old or above will be admitted to the dance.
- ❖ Students must have a current high school picture identification card (ID) or California ID.
- ❖ There will be NO tickets sold at the door.
- ❖ Tickets must be purchased through the ASB until 10/15
- ❖ All school rules apply.
- ❖ Students must enter the venue before 8:30pm. Students attempting to enter after 8:30pm WILL be denied entry. **NO REFUNDS FOR NON-ATTENDANCE**
- ❖ All attendees agree to remain at the venue. The earliest attendees and guests may leave will be 10:30 pm.
- ❖ You are responsible for any guest you bring to the dance.
- ❖ All guests must be approved by the Assistant Principals and must follow all school rules. All guests must arrive and leave with their EHS student sponsor.
- ❖ All attendees of the dance must leave the dance site or be picked up within 15 minutes from the conclusion of the dance.
- Dance ends at 11:00pm**
- ❖ No sexually explicit dancing (i.e.: freaking, grinding or dirty dancing) nor any dancing that may result in disruption or injury (i.e.: slamming or moshing) will be accepted.

### **Student Searches and Conduct**

- ❖ All students and are subject to random breathalyzer testing for alcohol or testing based upon reasonable suspicion at any school activity. Refusal to take a breath test will result in the student being denied entrance into the school event. No refund will be given. If a student is found to have alcohol in his/her system, the student will be detained by the Chula Vista Police Department, released to his/her parent and subject to disciplinary actions. Disciplinary actions may include suspension, possible involuntary transfer to another school, or expulsion. (Per California Education Code #48900)
- ❖ All students are subject to search of pockets, purses, jackets, and other possessions. It is recommended that students bring as few possessions/valuables as possible to avoid loss or theft. **The law provides school officials with wide latitude to search students, their possessions and automobiles in the ongoing effort to maintain a safe and secure environment and facility for all students. In the event that inappropriate item(s), illegal substances, etc., are found in a student’s possession, the student may be detained by the Sheriffs, released to his/her parent and subject to disciplinary actions. Disciplinary actions may include suspension, possible involuntary transfer to another school, or expulsion.**
- ❖ All school rules apply at school-sponsored events for both students and guests (whether the guest is a high school student or not). Violations will result in consequences, which may include detention, suspension, and possible expulsion. Both student and non-student violators may be subject to arrest and prosecution.
- ❖ No outside food or drink.
- ❖ Formal dance attire requires that students wear clothing that is neither too suggestive nor revealing.
- ❖ Shoes are required.
- ❖ All students and are subject to the same behavior and dress guidelines that govern SUHSD students.
- ❖ Any person removed from a dance by school supervision staff is not entitled to a refund.
