Article 2: Membership – Eligibility

- a. Must be a student body member
- b. States grade point average (G.P.A.) a member must have to qualify for membership
- c. States attendance eligibility a member must maintain to qualify for membership
- d. States administration and faculty are honorary members of the ASB

Article 3: Officers and Elections
